**[PROPOSED] ORDER RE:
PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

This Court, having considered Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction ("Preliminary Injunction Motion"), and all submissions and argument in connection therewith, and for the reasons stated on the record at the hearing held on February 3, 2011;


IT IS ORDERED this ^{JR}7 day of February 2011 as follows:

1. The Preliminary Injunction Motion is GRANTED.
2. Defendants, or any of their agents, attorneys, accountants or anyone acting in concert with any of them, are hereby preliminarily enjoined from taking any action that would result in the transfer of money out of any account (at any financial institution) as to which TransTech Services Partners, Inc. ("TransTech") is an owner, in whole or in part ("Financial Account"), including but not limited to HSBC Account Number 610-04105-3.
3. Defendants shall provide to Plaintiffs' counsel by electronic mail or facsimile, copies of each bank statement regarding any Financial Account for any period after December 31, 2010 and shall provide such copies within five business days of receipt.

4. Nothing shall prevent Defendants from seeking the approval of Plaintiffs' counsel for the withdrawal or transfer of *de minimis* amounts from any such Financial Account in accordance with this Court's ruling on the Preliminary Injunction Motion. Plaintiffs' consent shall not be unreasonably withheld. In the event the parties are unable to resolve any disagreement as to the withdrawal or transfer of *de minimis* amounts from any such Financial Account, nothing herein shall prevent Defendants from seeking relief from the Court.

5. This Order is issued on the condition that Plaintiffs shall file with this Court within ten days a surety bond in the face amount of \$20,000 for the payment of such damages as may be incurred or suffered by Defendants should it be determined by this Court that Defendants have been wrongfully restrained.

6. This Order shall be effective immediately and shall continue until further Order of this Court.
